ELIGIBILITY

- Unless he/she is under the age of 26 years (provided that the central government may, in any suitable case, relax the provisions of this clause).
- Unless he /she is on the roll of the University which is providing the unit or part thereof.



- Unless he/she satisfies such standard of physical fitness in height, chest measurement and other respects as may be specified by the Ministry of Defence, Government of India.
