Additionally, students were introduced to roadmap.sh, a platform that offers structured career paths for Computer Science students. The session provided valuable insights and practical strategies, helping students understand how to effectively utilize these tools to enhance their technical skills and career prospects.

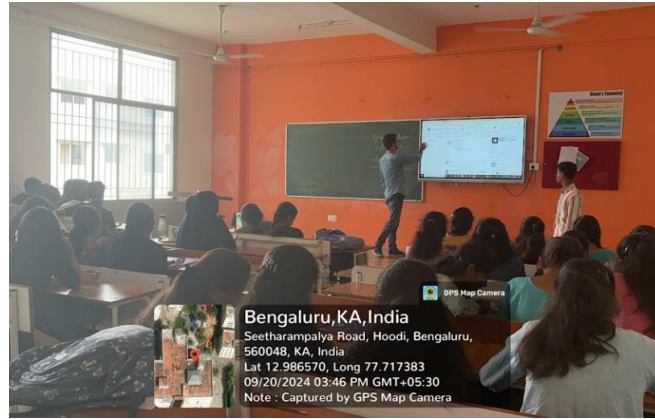
